


Sunset Pics in a Snap

When the sky is showing off a stunning sunset, many of us reach for our smartphones to snap a picture. But the photo usually pales in comparison to the real thing. Next time, try these tips to get amazing sunset shots using just a smartphone camera.

- Take the photo horizontally, aka landscape mode, to capture more of the sky's colors. Keep the horizon level by turning on the camera's gridline guide.
- Rather than just shooting the sky, look for a subject, such as a building or tree, to include in your picture. The contrast will make the sunset's colors pop.
- Hold your phone closer to your body to keep it stable, which helps reduce blurry photos.



Sit Back and Relax

Recognized for their reclined back and wide armrests, Adirondack chairs invite you to lean back and lounge awhile. This popular design has been copied since it was first created in 1903 by Thomas Lee. Double the Hydration

Nutrition experts say you can double up your hydration by snacking on fresh produce. Eating fruits and veggies with a high water content, such as an apple or some carrot sticks, along with drinking H2O can help you stay better hydrated.

Firecrackin' Art

Black cats, dragons, cowboys and rocket ships—these are just some of the subjects that have appeared on fireworks packaging since the early 1900s. That's when lithography printing machines arrived in China, allowing firecracker manufacturers to design colorful labels to set their products apart from competitors. Some artwork introduced Americans to Chinese mythology and landmarks, while others reflected current pop culture. Nowadays, vintage fireworks art has many collectors and has even been featured at the Smithsonian Institution.

Wild World: Great Blue Heron

This striking bird can be found all across North America, where it nests near rivers, swamps and other bodies of water. It often stands as still as a statue while looking for fish, allowing birdwatchers to admire its long legs, slate gray body, curved neck, and bright yellow eyes and bill. The largest herons on the continent, they stand 3 to 4 feet tall and have a wingspan of nearly 6 feet. Despite their size, these birds weigh only around 5 pounds, thanks to hollow bones, a feature of most birds.
