A: They suspected fowl play.


Q: What do you call a turkey on the day after Thanksgiving?

Remember When: Pie Safes

You may have seen a pie safe in an antique store or even an older relative's home while you were growing up. Also called a pie cabinet, cupboard or chest, this piece of furniture originated in the 1700s with Pennsylvania Dutch communities and soon spread to other regions in the U.S. Long before the days of built-in cabinetry and refrigeration, freestanding furniture was used for kitchen storage. A pie safe was used to protect pies, breads and other baked goods from pests, and the doors were made from wooden slats or perforated tin, providing ventilation to keep food cool and safe to eat. Nowadays, pie safes are popular collectors' items, often repurposed to hold linens or dishware.
